Lawrence A. Anzuoni, Sr., an icon in the transportation industry for over 60 years passed away yesterday surrounded by his family after losing his battle with a long term illness.

Mr. Anzuoni was President of Brush Hill Transportation Co. Inc of Randolph, Massachusetts and along with his brothers George and Richard, owned Brush Hill, Plymouth & Brockton St. Rwy. Co., McGinn Bus, North Shore Bus and the Gray Line Sightseeing of Boston and Cape Cod and the Beantown Trolley.

Instrumental in furthering the cause of tourism in Massachusetts he lobbied at the State House to create policy changes in the laws governing the transportation industry. He was a Lifetime Director (Emeritus) of the Greater Boston Convention and Visitor's Bureau; past president of many industry associations and a member of NEBA, NEPTA, ABA, NTA etc. He received the Transportation Man of the Year Award from NEPTA and was also a recipient of the NEPTA Hall of Fame Award in 2004.

He will be sorely missed in the industry and by all who knew him as a friend.
